### **SUPPLY LIST**

#### **Paint:**

- Hansa Yellow or Cadmium Lemon Light
- Yellow Ochre
- Cadmium Red Light
- Alizarin Crimson
- Ultramarine Blue
- Pthalo Blue or Prussian Blue
- Titanium White
- Burnt Sienna

**Brushes:** Flat sizes 6, 12, 16 and a couple of small rounds. I like synthetic sable brushes.

- 8 x 10 canvas
- Gamsol
- A Glass jar with a lid
- Paper towels. I like the blue automotive ones; they are very absorbent.
- Palette. I use a glass cutting board. Please don't get a plastic palette.
- A diamond-shaped palette knife
- A small jar of Liquin or Gamblin's solvent free gel.
- Pencil and notebook.
